What are Franchised Solid Waste Removal Services?

In 2009, McHenry County Department of Health began the process of evaluating the potential to facilitate franchised solid waste removal services for approximately 4200 residences in three (3) unincorporated areas of Wonder Lake and McHenry. These areas were particularly impacted by the recently revised open burning restrictions. One of the primary considerations was to provide an economical alternative for proper disposal of landscape

waste. Through a competitive bidding process, a single vendor was selected to provide comprehensive solid waste removal and recycling services for the residents. The program, which was implemented in 2010, includes a volume based pricing system where participants' cost is based upon the amount of refuse discarded. Unlimited seasonal landscape waste pick-up, multiple bulk leaf collections, unlimited recycling, and options for disposal of large

items are also included.

Staff has confirmed a significant reduction in solid waste enforcement issues in these designated areas since the implementation of the program. Residents have indicated an appreciation for the comprehensive services at an affordable cost and the significant reduction in wear and tear on the roads from having less heavy vehicles travelling providing garbage pick- up.

Staff has also documented ex-

cellent solid waste diversion rates in the designated areas receiving franchised solid waste services. The solid waste diversion rate is approximately 5% higher than the overall county rate.

In 2012 additional franchised solid waste removal services were provided 1400 residences in unincorporated Crystal Lake and Spring Grove. For more information, visit www.mcdh.info or call (815) 334-4585

Yard waste is banned from Illinois landfills (Christmas trees are excluded) and open burning is limited in McHenry County.

Most municipalities have a system for collecting landscape waste. Call for more information.

McHenry County Open Burning of Landscape Waste Regulations:

The Open Burning of Landscape Waste Ordinance became effective April 1, 2008 and applies to all areas of McHenry County. If you live in a city with more stringent restrictions, the more restrictive rules apply.

- shred your leaves
- compost in your backyard

• use grass as ground cover or in flower beds Reducing the amount of grass you grow and replacing it with ground covers or native wildflower beds invites birds and butterflies to your yard. Birds will serve as nature's insecticide.

Pre-consumer: recovered and post industrial: refer to surplus industry, industrial scraps, paper cuttings, and plastic shavings which have been collected by the factory and sent back into the manufacturing process. To make sure you are buying recycled, read the package labels carefully.

Recyclable: includes the reuse, reconditioning and remanufacturing of products or parts in another product. Note: these products may not have recycled content. Check the label.

Recycled content: includes products and packages that contain reused, reconditioned or remanufactured materials, as well as recycled raw materials.

Should you flush leftover medications? No! They pollute waterways. They can be dropped off at "take-back" programs in McHenry County: Johnsburg, Spring Grove and Fox River Grove Police Stations.

80% of the plastic bottles sold are not recycled. 24 million gallons of oil are needed to produce a billion plastic bottles.

Don't like the taste of your local tap water? Inexpensive carbon filters will turn most tap water sparkling fresh at a fraction of bottled water's cost. If you turn an electronic appliance off, it's off, right? Wrong! Several products continue to suck power even in off mode. Be energy efficient and invest in a power strip.

E-WASTE (electronic waste) is NOT waste, it is a resource. Useful materials such as glass, copper, aluminum, plastic and other components can be extracted and reused. In the U.S., about 40% of all edible food goes into a landfill, according to the Natural Resource Defense Council. **Fix those drippy faucets NOW!** A single faucet dripping once every second can waste almost 2000 gallons per year—or over 5 ½ gallons per day.

Besides cans, other types of aluminum can be recycled: siding, gutters, storm window frames, and lawn furniture. Find a scrap metal dealer and make extra cash.
